## **FCC Announces Prohibition of Wireless Microphone Operation in the 700 MHz Band**

In accordance with the recent reorganization of the UHF spectrum, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has prohibited the sale, offer for sale, or shipment of wireless microphones in the 698-806 MHz range (known as the 700 MHz band), effective June 12, 2010.

In anticipation of this event, Ansr Audio, Inc. has ceased all sales and repairs to prohibited equipment and components effective January 1, 2010.

**Wireless microphone operation outside of the 700 MHz band is still approved. All current Ansr Audio and Special Projects Audio wireless products are approved for use by the FCC and are not affected by this order.**

**If you are using a Scan16, Scan700, Aqua 20/20 system, or any Group.X product, your systems are approved for use by the FCC.**

Also note that many older Ansr Audio and Special Projects Audio systems operate outside of the prohibited range and are still approved for use. If you are unsure, check the product label on the back or underside of the receiver for the operating range.
